<u>Principal's Report</u> Mr. McMeekin

Mr. McMeekin discussed staffing update: Interviewing for P.E. and Social Science but no in house applicants for science positions so will post to general population. Some AP tests will be moved to late administration, the third week of May (for more prep time) from standard: AP Environmental Science, AP Statistics, AP Economics, AP English Literature, AP English Language, AP World History over a one-week period instead of two.
