*Mr. McMeekin discussed staffing update: Two teachers are retiring, two more are resigning so 4 new teachers are needed. Rowina the Office Manager is taking a District Office position and still looking for a good fit for our office so will repost position. Will also post for permanent Campus Monitor. There are no layoffs planned though the budget does not support the current staffing. Testing: 166 of 193 Juniors took the SAT test though colleges no longer require it for acceptance. AP testing is the first two weeks of May and we'll need parents to assist in proctoring during the school day. SBAC Juniors, Math and ELA. Seniors, Science. School Site Council Update: Create staff for parent engagement strategies. Parent flyer survey regarding racist graffiti. Student group can develop and create Equity Committee. Mask recommendation is through April 18<sup>th</sup>. Prom is June 4<sup>th</sup> at 7pm and graduation is at Sutter Health Park, June 15<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm. School Listening Circles were 2 meetings per day and the most attended were 5 parents. Refer conversation topic ideas to Mr. McMeekin.*
